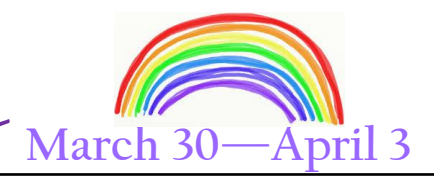




Kindergarten Choice Board
